Introduction to the UTC Oxfordshire

- Proposed to open in Didcot in September 2015 with 140 places for girls and boys in Year 10 and Year 12
- Would eventually grow to 600 students aged 14 to 19
- Would specialise in life sciences, physical sciences and advanced engineering
- No fees
- No entrance tests for Year 10
- 15 mile catchment area including Oxfordshire, Newbury, Reading, Aylesbury and West Wycombe
- Supported by leading local employers to offer specialist learning and employer accreditation
- Key Stage 4 curriculum (Years 10 and 11) – core GCSEs and options to include additional GCSEs and BTEC qualifications
- Key Stage 5 options (Years 12 and 13) – A-levels, BTEC qualifications, specialist learning and a strong emphasis on leadership and employability skills
- Clear progression for all students into higher education, further education, employment and apprenticeships
